By exhibiting these objects, **refuse** proclaims a revolutionary re-definition of design excellence, which may no longer be described without embracing environmental as well as aesthetic values. Concentrating on industrially produced consumer goods, **refuse** incorporates the work of such noted designers as Frank Gehry, Phillippe Starck, Eya Ziesel and Michele de Lucchi.
